Our largest class Thursday was the factory light class with 6 shooters, followed by the sporter class with 5.

Dennis Bennett led the way shooting his CZ452 with an impressive score of 250/13X's in the factory light class. Dave Roberts shooting 2 different Anschutzes doubled up with wins in the sporter class and match rifle class, shooting identical scores of 250/11X's.

I know that the match results make it look like a factory gun scores higher, better than the sporter & match rifle guns. At PHA we use three different targets: factory gun & light sporter gun target has a ten ring of 7/8 of an inch, whereby the match rifle & sporter target has a ten ring of 1/2 inch. The open site target is a standard 50 yard target.

The biggest winner of the day was Keith Raulston who won the prestigious Harbor Freight award. Keith chose a set of custom screwdrivers. Thanks to Dave Roberts who came out early to help set up.
