Our February Vintage Military match was held on a partially overcast (threatening rain but didn't) day. Five competitors showed up to shoot. Wayne was high shooter with his M1 with a 265-1 and Will was second with his K31 Swiss firing a 256-2

Our next Vintage match will be on Sat, 23 March 2024.

There is a possibility we will occasionally run a "sniper" course of fire after our 2 matches during the year. The thought is now that we use 25 meter M16 qual targets at 100 yards. That would make the targets SMALL. This could be a "team" type of match with a spotter for each shooter. Use of Vintage rifles would be required. Obviously scopes would be necessary. I know there are several of our shooters that have Vintage sniper set-ups, maybe we could let others who don't have one use them for the match. At this time we are thinking an 8 round course. If there is interest in doing this, please email us as soon as possible. Targets need to be ordered and we need to make sure we have the gear to set targets up at the 100 yard line. This shouldn't take but an hour at most as we project it. All targets would be hung and shot, then score them all at once. If you are not familiar with the targets, just search the web for "M16 A1 25 meter alternate course C record fire qualification" targets. There are 10 "targets" on the paper and would be shooter's choice of 2 of the last 4 silhouettes. If there is enough interest, the match could be opened to modern as well.

Range setup is everyone's responsibility, so we need the help first thing.
